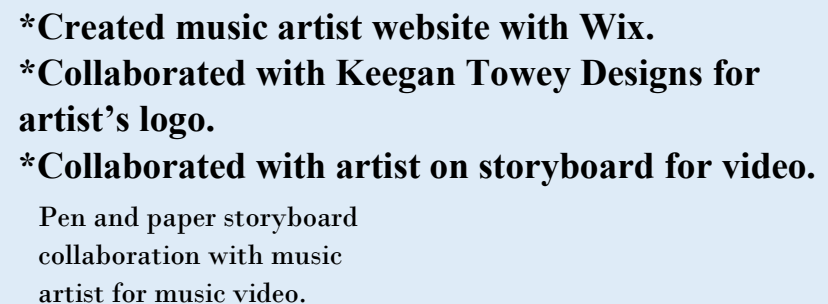
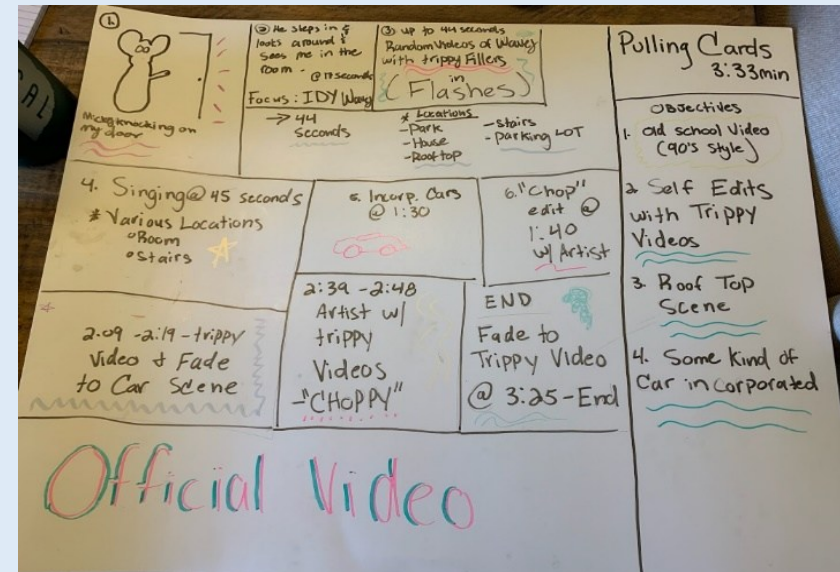

Formative Assessment Quick Reference

Content Knowledge

(Facts, Knowledge, Theories)

Provides evidence between knowledge and practice. Implements retainment of information as opposed to regurgitation of information.

After each lesson, learners take a quick quiz that covers general understanding of each topic before moving onto next topic.

Learning Technique:
In Person, Online, Blended

Best Used: Any platform where students are expected to provide evidence of learned objectives.

Directed Paraphrasing

(Written or Verbal)

Helps learners and teachers assess how information is learned through learner expressing content into their own words.

After each lesson, learners paraphrase their understanding of the topic (written or verbal).

Learning Technique:
In Person, Online, Blended

Best Used: To effectively communicate complex ideas with non-technical language.

Four Corners

(Engaging & Interactive)

Promotes listening, verbal communication, critical thinking, and decision-making.

After a lesson, each corner of the classroom is assigned to represent a response to a question regarding a specific topic of the instruction.

Learning Technique:
In Person

Best Used: To promote listening, communication, critical thinking, and decision-making.

Process Oriented

(Step, Procedure, Task)

Creates a framework for solving a problem by stepping through a process sequence.

After the lesson, have learners provide the steps and procedures for their answer of understanding.

Learning Technique: In Person, Online, Blended

Best Used: When creating a platform to solve a problem or when step by step instructions are required.

Plickers

(Flexible & Engaging)

Provides a way of asking questions and receiving immediate feedback.

Each learner is given a predetermined answer card or tool that represents an answer. After each lesson, instructor asks questions and learners immediate reply with their card or tool.

Learning Technique: In Person, Online, Blended

Best Used: When numbers or symbols can replace answers, trying to obtain consensus, or when internet is not available.

Discussion Question & Discussion Boards

(Engaging & Interactive)

Helps learners process information instead of just receiving it. Assists learners in improving communication skills.

After a lesson, ask a question pertinent to material to engage learners in communication (questions can be predetermined). If the course is online, define expectations of engagement in discussions.

Award Winning Pineapple & Habanero Jam

(Recipe Makes 3 Pints)

Equipment Needed

Pint Size Canning Jars (3)
Canning Pot
Canning Tongs
Canning Funnel
Blender or Food Processor
Large (6 Quart) Pot
Wooden Spoon
Cooling Rack

Ingredients

2 ½ Cups White Granulated Sugar
2 Pineapples (Cored & Cubed)
3 Habanero Peppers (Minced)
1 Package Sure-Jell Original Pectin

Directions to Make Jam

1. Core and Cube Pineapple. Set aside.
2. Mince Habanero Peppers.
3. Add pineapple and habanero peppers to food processor or blender and puree.
4. Place cooking pot in middle of stove burner and turn to medium heat.
5. Add pureed mixture into cooking pot.
6. Add 2 ½ Cups of white granulated sugar stirring occasionally until mixture comes to a slow boil.
7. Once mixture comes to a slow boil remove from heat and add one (1) package of Sure-Jell Original Pectin to mixture.
8. Return mixture to stove stirring continuously until mixture comes to a slow boil then remove from heat after 2-3 minutes boiling.

Directions to Can Jam

1. Using canning funnel, fill jars with mixture to just under the rim of the jar.
2. Place lids and bands lightly on the jars.
3. Submerge jars in water bath.
4. Keep in water bath 8-10 minutes.
5. Remove jars with canning tongs and place on cooling rack.
6. DO NOT remove or touch lids. Keep jars on cooling rack until they are at room temperature.

*NOTE: Jars will seal on their own. They will make a "POP" sound when the seal is complete. If there is no pop sound and you can push in lid and hear a sound, they have not cooked properly. Immediately throw away to prevent bacteria growth.

How to Sterilize Canning Jars

* Jam is made in a water bath.

1. Fill Canning Pot with water (enough to submerge pint jars) and bring to a boil.
2. To sterilize jars, submerge jars in boiling water for approximately 10 minutes.
3. Remove jars with Canning Tongs and place on cooling rack until completely cooled.
4. Clean and Rinse Canning Pot.
5. Refill pot with fresh water (1-2 inches above canning jars and bring to a boil (lid on).
5. Once water has boiled turn temperature to medium-high. Keep covered until jam is ready for water bath.

How to Core & Cube a Pineapple

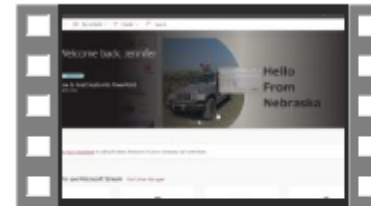
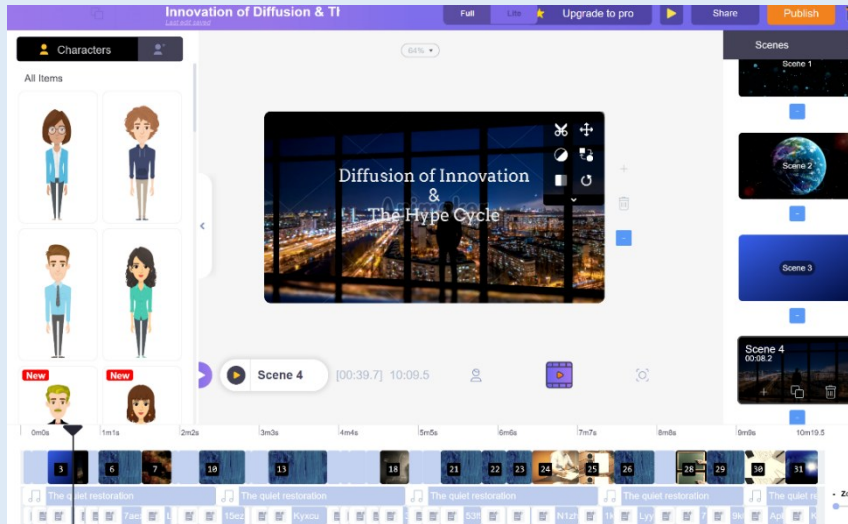
1. On a cutting board, lay pineapple on side and cut top and bottom so that there is a flat surface on both sides.
2. Holding pineapple upright, slice off the spiky sides.
3. Continuing with the pineapple upright, cut around the core (the center of the pineapple). This should give you four large slices.
4. Once pineapple is cut into 4 core-less pieces, lay them flat on the cutting board and cut them into cube size (about 1-2 inches).

How to Mince a Habanero Pepper

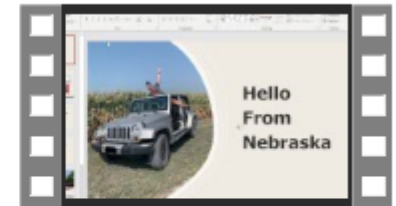
1. It is recommended to wear gloves.
2. Slice habanero peppers lengthwise and remove stem.
3. Deseed peppers. Take out seeds and veins.
4. Slice peppers lengthwise and then horizontally to mince.

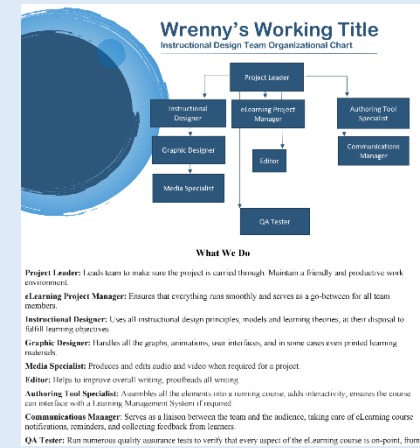

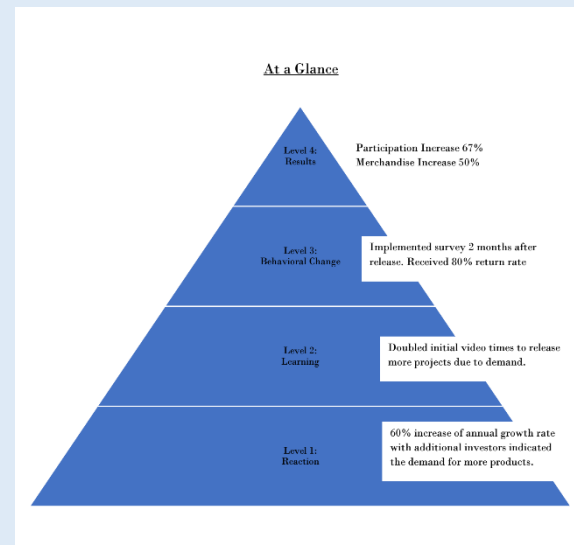
